

1. Top Up your card

Travel Credit works just like phone credit. You Top Up your card and then the cost of your fare is deducted from your balance every time you travel.

You can Top Up your Leap Card with Travel Credit:

- At any Leap Card shop. There are over 400 in Dublin. Just look for the Leap Card sign.
- At Luas, DART and Commuter Rail ticket machines in the Dublin area.

2. Pay As You Go (PAYG)

For City Centre, short (1 -3 stages), medium (4 -7 stages) and long (8-13 stages) journeys tell the driver your destination and hold your Card to the target on the driver's ticket machine and the correct fare will be deducted from your Travel Credit. For longer journeys (over 13 stages) use the Validator on the right hand side as you enter the bus and the flat fare will be

If you are unsure which fare applies to your journey, ask the driver. Please note, you do not need to Touch Off at the validator when exiting the Bus.

To PAYG On Luas

Touch On at a Validator on the platform before you get on the tram and Touch Off when you get off the tram. A default fare will be deducted from the Travel Credit on your card when you Touch On; and when you Touch Off the appropriate amount will be refunded to your card for your journey.

To PAYG on DART & Commuter Rail

Touch On at the platform entry gate or Validator before your journey and Touch Off at the platform exit gate or Validator after your journey. A default fare will be deducted from the Travel Credit on your card when you Touch On; and when you Touch Off the appropriate amount will be refunded to your card for your journey. If you do not Touch Off before leaving the station the default fare will be applied. The card can be used between stations within the 'Short Hop Zone'. This Zone includes all stations in the Dublin area from Greystones to Balbriggan, and Commuter Stations from Dublin City Centre to Maynooth and from Dublin Heuston to Hazelhatch.

Dublin Bus	Touch On only
Luas	Touch On and Touch Off
DART & Commuter Rail	Touch On and Touch Off

When you have Touched On or Touched Off you'll hear a tone and see a message on the Validator screen to let you know you've been successful.

Always take your Leap Card out of your wallet when Touching On or Off, as other cards may inadvertently be read by the Validator e.g. if you have a Dublin Bus Rambler ticket.
